THE ANNEMARIE QUINN TRIO

CROW DOG

EMILY FORD

ESP
Playing lounge music in a jazzy, laid-back, funky style – easy listening! Recorded the charity single 'Over the Rainbow' in support of West Cumbrian flood victims.

FAIN
A distinctive classical-folk repertoire for voices, violin and keyboard, with French and Celtic traditional music including songs, dance tunes and soulful slow airs.

FEED ME
Young blues band with their own original take on the blues, playing a mixture of their own songs and revitalised classics. Their debut album is 'Blood on the Moon'.

FIVE LOADED GUNS
A young classic/hard-rock band playing covers and some original material, with covers ranging from Airbourne and AC/DC to Nirvana and The Undertones.

JAN BECK
An exciting selection of original compositions for solo acoustic guitar, with roots in flamenco, jazz, folkloric, classical and rock.

JAZZHAVEN
Playing listenable jazz – a mixture of standards and well-trying arrangements with vocal features.

JOHN AND WAYNE
Hailing from West Cumbria, their original songs and humour are steeped in tales of their musical and personal lives to date, including life on the road as both musicians and joiners!

KITCHIE WUD
An alternative three-piece acoustic rock/folk band playing their own material and covering artists such as Foo Fighters, Skunk Anansie, The Killers and Alanis Morissette.

KRAZY ARTS DRAMA
A trial for immortal souls in Market Place, where a vampire is facing a punishment worse than death. Will you help decide her fate? Performed by Kirkgate-based youth arts group 'Krazy Arts', and written by Millie Hardy-Sims.

LAST MAN STANDING
Five-piece band playing a wide range of styles based on R&B, soul and indie from the last few decades to the present day.

LES BULL'S JAZZ BAND
Well-known band playing Chicago-style jazz and jazz standards. Tickets £6, £3 child, with Pie and Peas lunch for an additional £1.50.

LONG PLAY
New young band playing a variety of Northumbrian, Scandinavian, Irish and Scottish folk music.

MIKE WILLOUGHBY AND CAROLYN FRANCIS
Multi-instrumental folk duo playing Cumbrian songs and tunes with verve and energy, well-known for playing with the ceilidh band Striding Edge.

MOUTHING OFF
Cockermouth School's theatre company Mouting Off have devised several brand-new pieces of theatre especially for the festival, taking their inspiration from their town and its natural surroundings.

PHYSICAL JERKS
One of Britain's top bboying crews. Watch their break dance performance in the morning, then come back later for their FREE public workshop! This is followed by a performance including the workshop participants.

PIPE DREAM
An acoustic duo formed out of a desire to play music by Opeth and Zero 7; this soon progressed into writing new songs in a similar style.

RADIO SILENCE
Classic rock with a modern contemporary twist. In unplugged format, playing music from The Who and Pink Floyd through to KT Tunstall and Lady GaGa, as well as original material.

SID WRIGHT
A mix of folk old and new, with original material and covers from George Harrison to Britney Spears.

SPRING TIDE
Song, story and epic adventure from Storytree. Thrown up by the spring tide, Captain George Oldmajiggins has a story to tell, full of amazing discoveries and great danger!

STAGECOACH THEATRE ARTS
Talented students present a selection of entertaining numbers such as Indian dancing, comedy sketches and much more.

THE SUSPENDED
A quartet incorporating a vast array of influences, from metal to indie, into their hyper, post-punk revival sound, with catchy riffs and insightful lyrics.

TRADITIONAL MUSIC SESSION
An ever-changing all-day session, gathering together traditional musicians from all corners of Cumbria, with fiddles, melodeons, guitars, flutes and more. Drop in throughout the day to hear what's happening!

VAL LEACH
Baroque keyboard music by composers such as Bach, Handel, Haydn, Vivaldi and others, plus songs that would have been popular at the time.

WATER'S EDGE
A three-piece band who write and perform original material – melodic acoustic songs with a dynamic edge.
